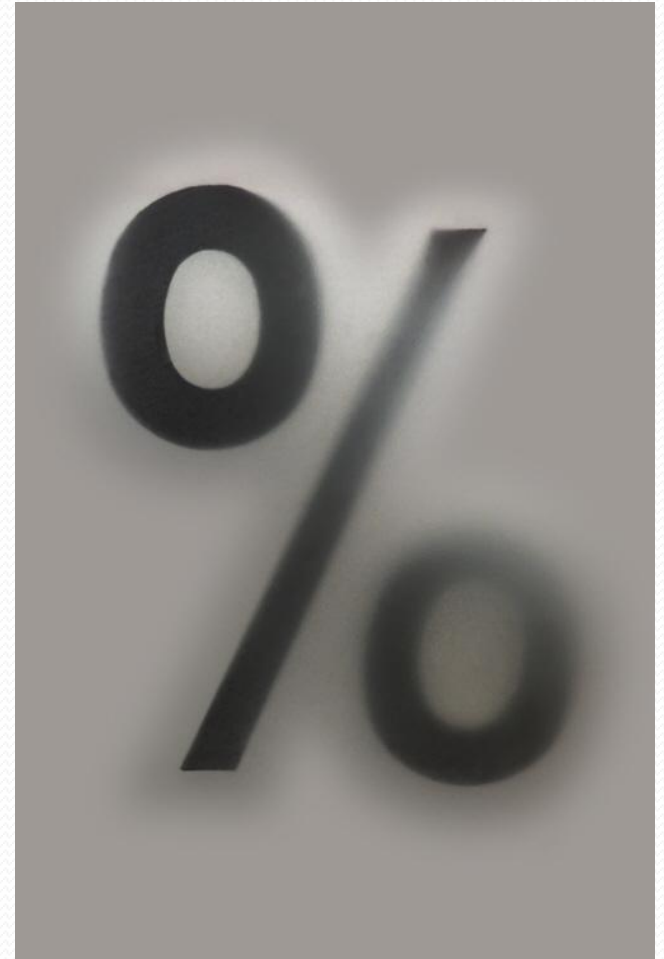

# Motivation for the Study

- To determine if institutions have achieved the long-standing perception of one percentage point gain in retention and graduation rates.
- To determine the range of graduation rates and gains/losses at institutions.



# Motivation for the Study

- To acquire additional data on four-year institutions in order to evaluate graduation rates of peers in our region.
- To determine the number of students NOT being counted in graduation rates.





# Definitions

- Retention Rate: “A measure of the rate at which students persist in their educational program at an institution, expressed as a percentage. For four-year institutions, this is the percentage of first-time bachelors (or equivalent) degree-seeking undergraduates from the previous fall who are again enrolled in the current fall” (IPEDS, 2008).



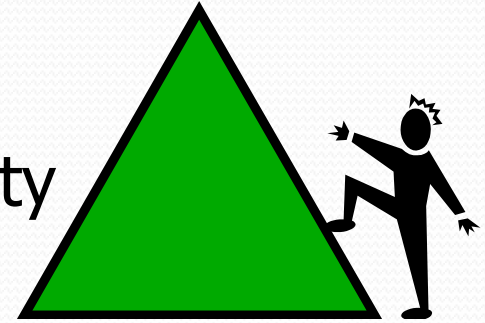
# Definitions

- Graduation Rate: “The rate required for disclosure and/or reporting purposes under Student Right-to-Know. This rate is calculated as the total number of completers within 150% of normal time divided by the revised cohort minus any allowable exclusions” (IPEDS, 2008).



# Brief Literature Review

- Institutions conform to the accountability triangle illustrated by Burke and Associates (2005).
  - Colleges and universities must adhere to “state priorities, academic concerns, and market forces” (p. 23).
- Higher education serves students, parents, state and local economies, politics, and many other stakeholders and sectors.
  - Retained students = revenue for the institution





# Brief Literature Review

- Efforts made must equally contribute to all three areas of the accountability triangle: state priorities, academic concerns, and market forces.
  - Retention and graduation rates as a measure of accountability



# Brief Literature Review

- The study utilized the Policy Diffusion Framework developed by Berry and Berry (1990, 1992).
  - The essential idea behind the framework is that development of a policy is a “function of both their characteristics of the specific political systems and a variety of diffusion processes” (Sabatier, 1999, p. 10).



# Brief Literature Review

- Applicable to retention and graduation:
  - Institutions are competitive with their peers.
  - Must comply with federal policies (i.e., reporting retention and graduation rates)



# Research Questions

1. What is a reasonable gain in a retention rate?
  - Are there financial factors (total revenues) that can help to increase a institution's retention rate?
2. What is a reasonable gain in a graduation rate?
  - Are there financial factors (total revenues) that can help to increase a institution's graduation rate?
3. How many students are NOT counted in graduation rates?



# RQ1 & 2 - Data, Variables, and Methods

**Retrieved IPEDS data for all institutions in the United States and its territories from 2004 to 2007**

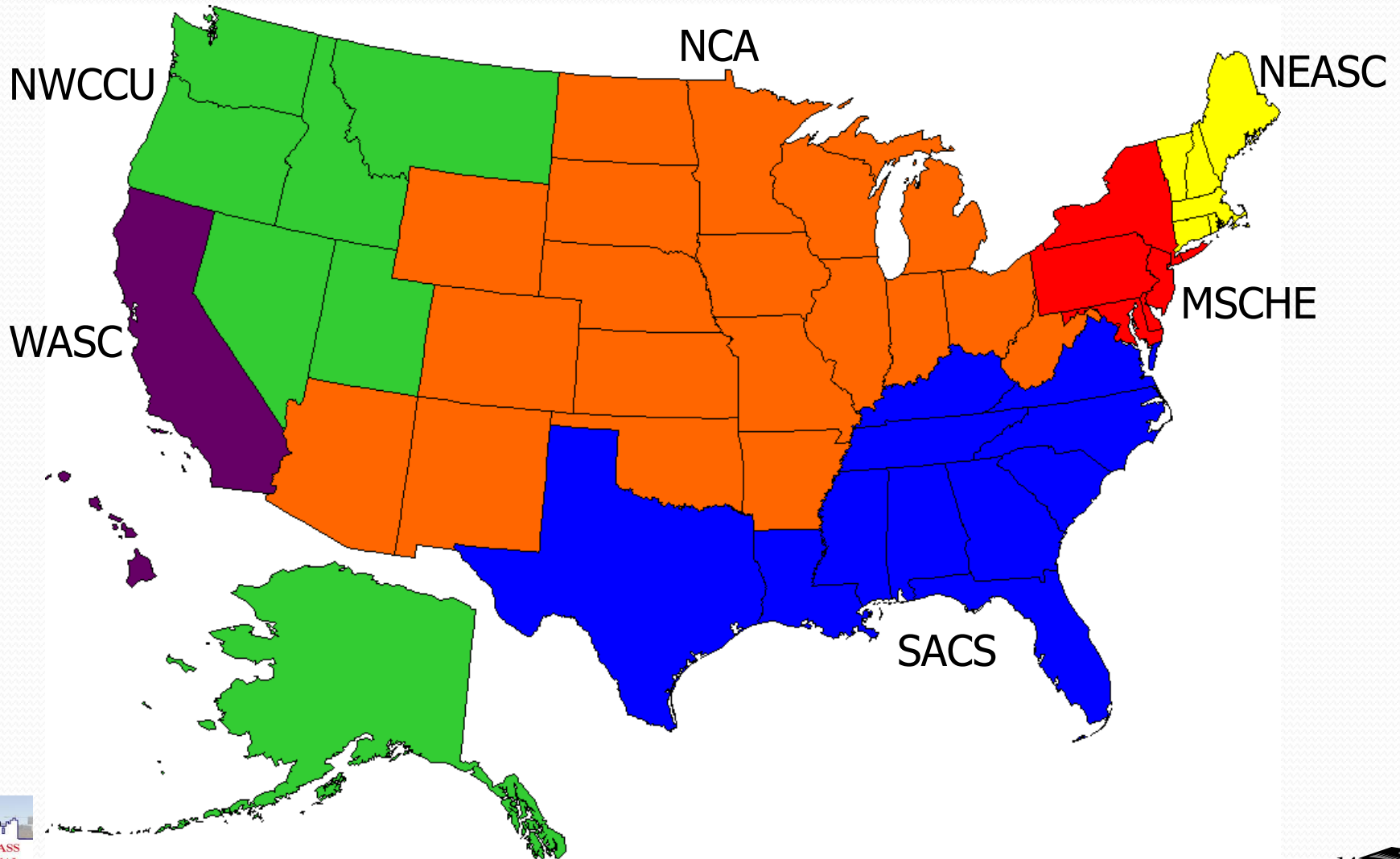
**Incorporated all data into Excel and differentiated groups by accrediting agencies. We focused on 4-year public institutions**

**Imported data into SPSS and quartile categories were created for selected variables**

**Deleted institutions that did not report retention rates and graduation rates for 2005, 2006, or 2007 (n=535)**

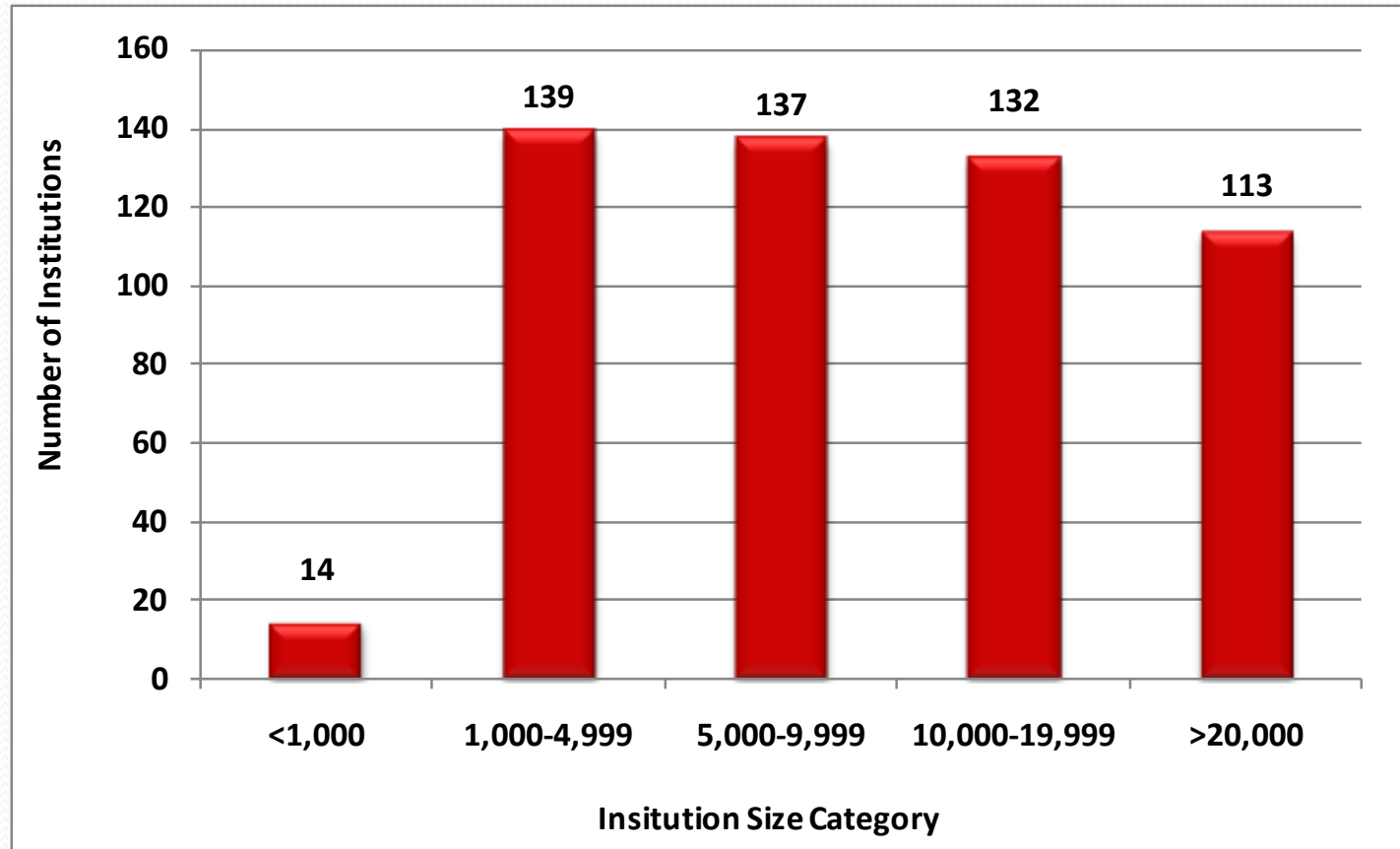


# RQ1 & 2 – Accreditation Regions



# RQ1 & 2 - About the Institutions...

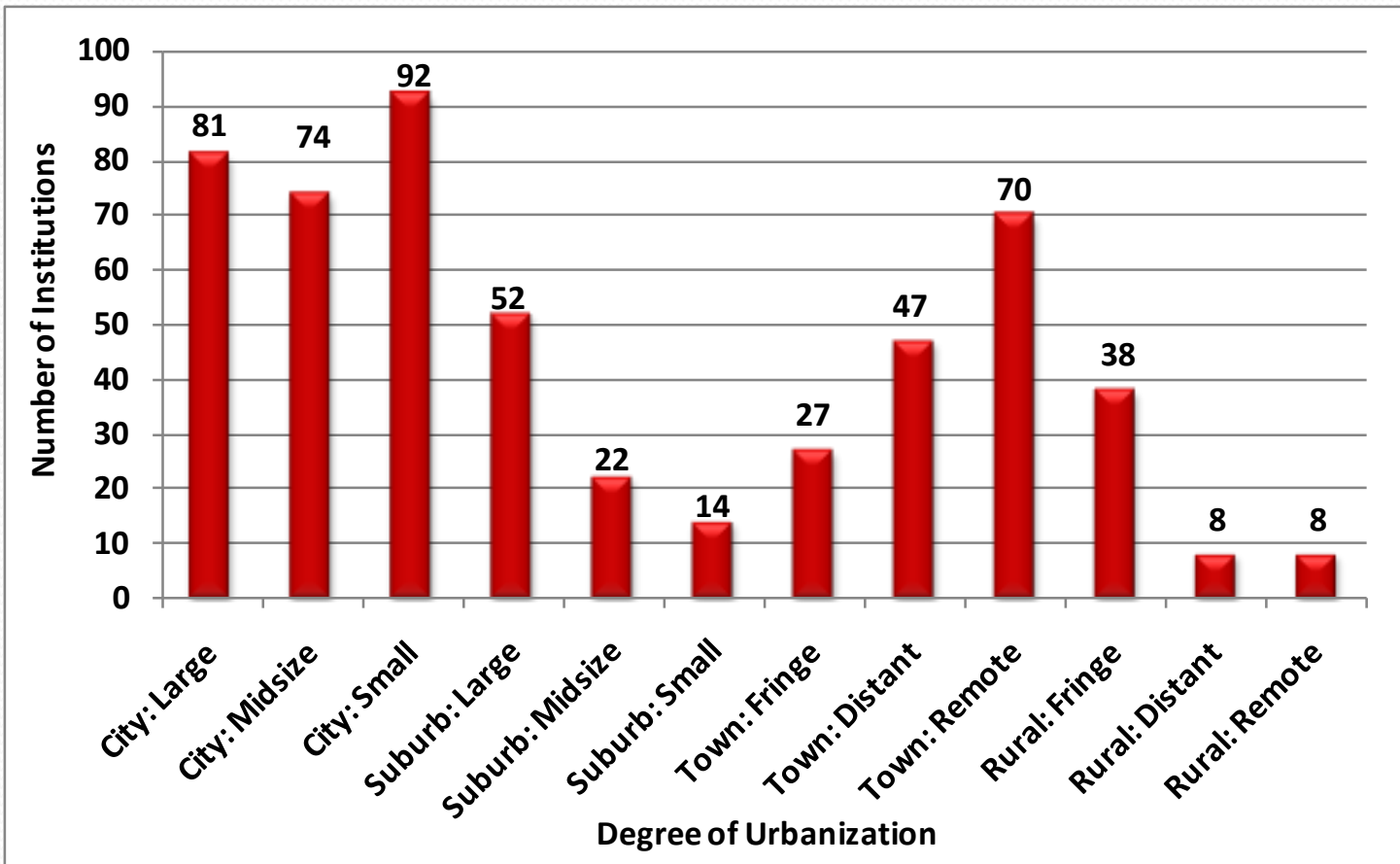
- The majority 76.26% of institutions are defined as having between 1,000 students and 19,999 students.
- There are 113 (21.12%) institutions that have over 20,000 students.

# RQ1 & 2 - About the Institutions...

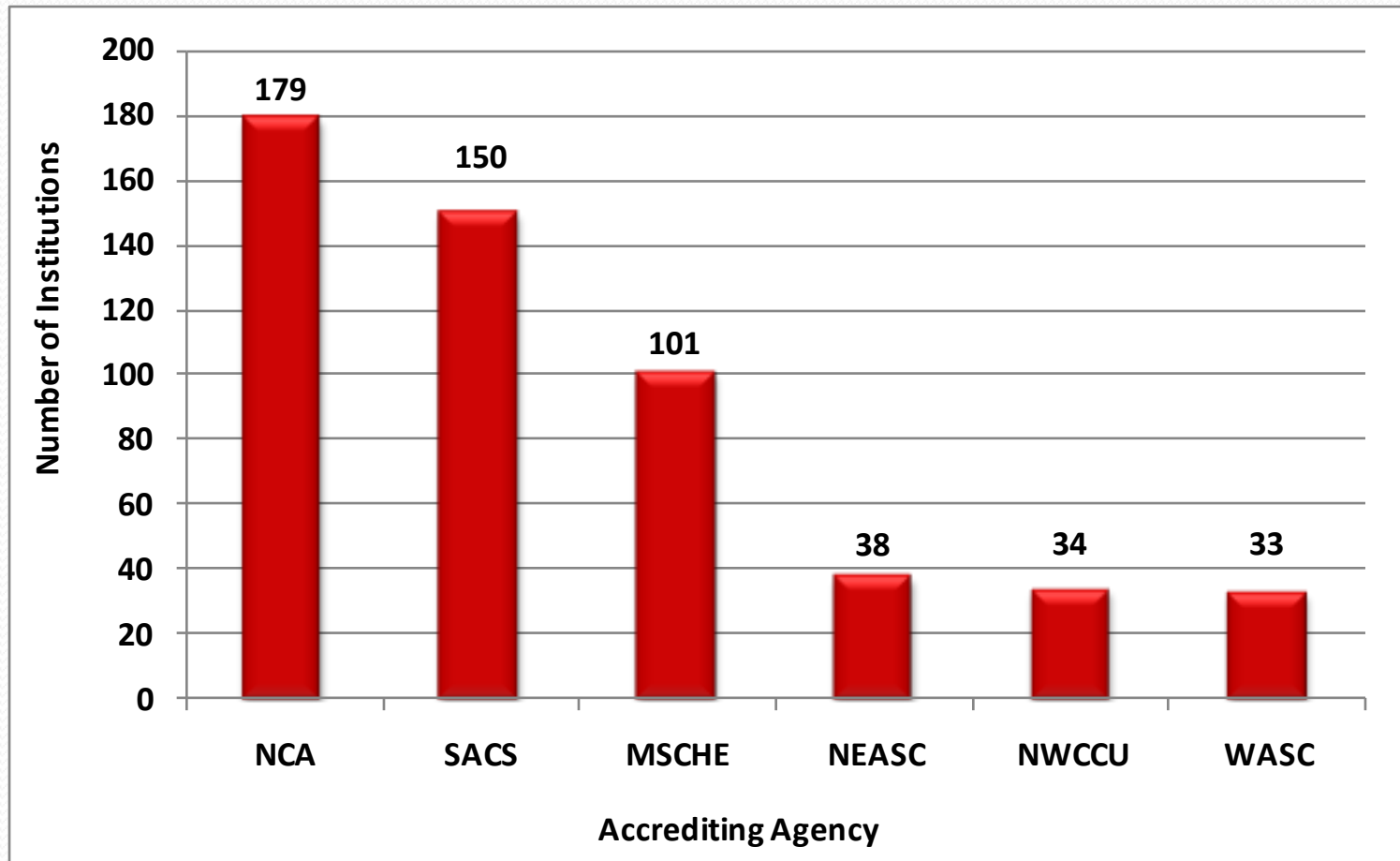
- Studied Institutions—42.8% are located in cities or suburbs with populations greater than 100,000.

# RQ1 & 2 - About the Institutions...

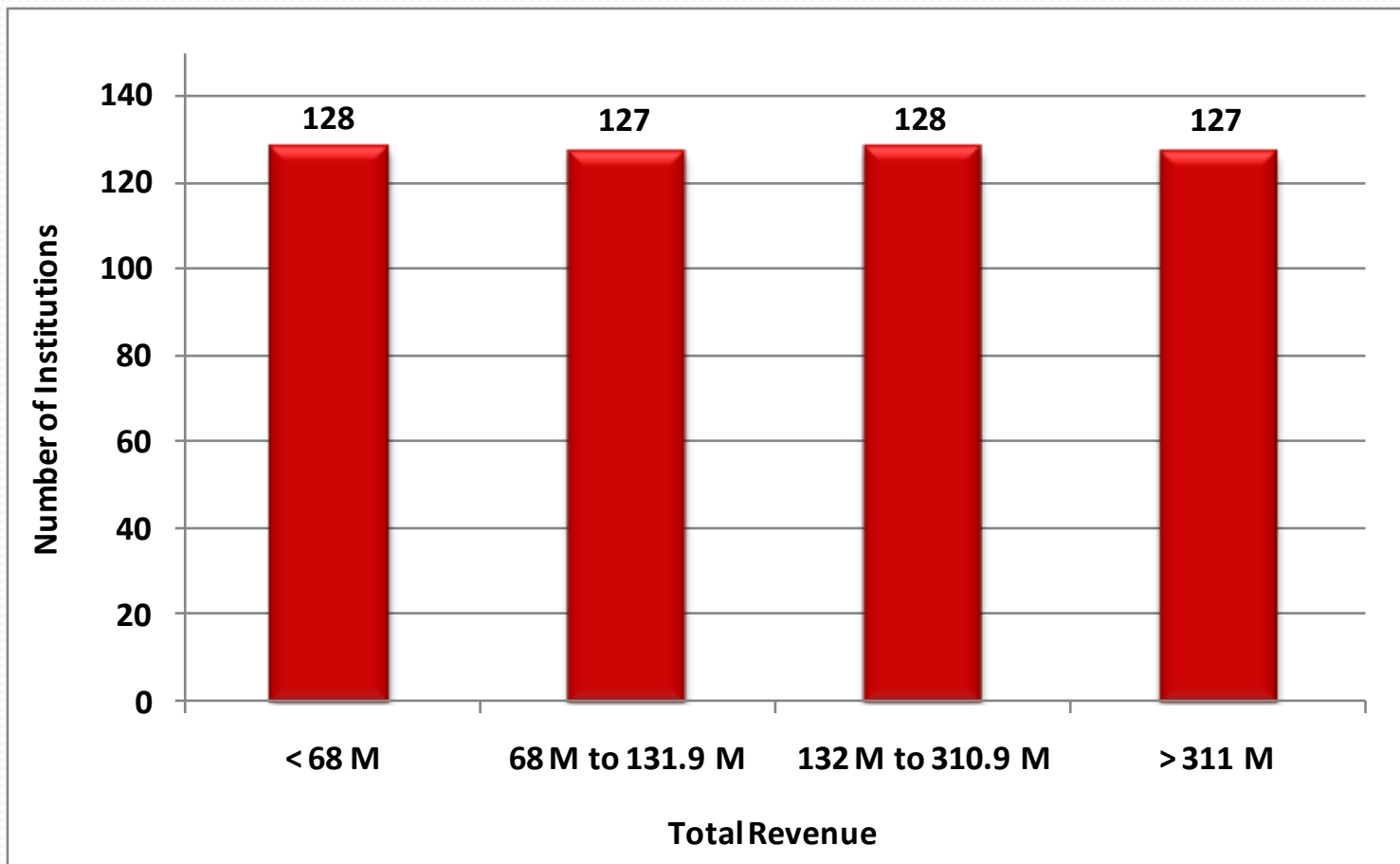
- NCA has the largest number of institutions (179) in the study.

# RQ1 & 2 - About the Institutions...

- Of the 535 institutions studied, the total revenue generated in fiscal year 2005 ranged from \$5,734,833 to \$5,879,700,000.



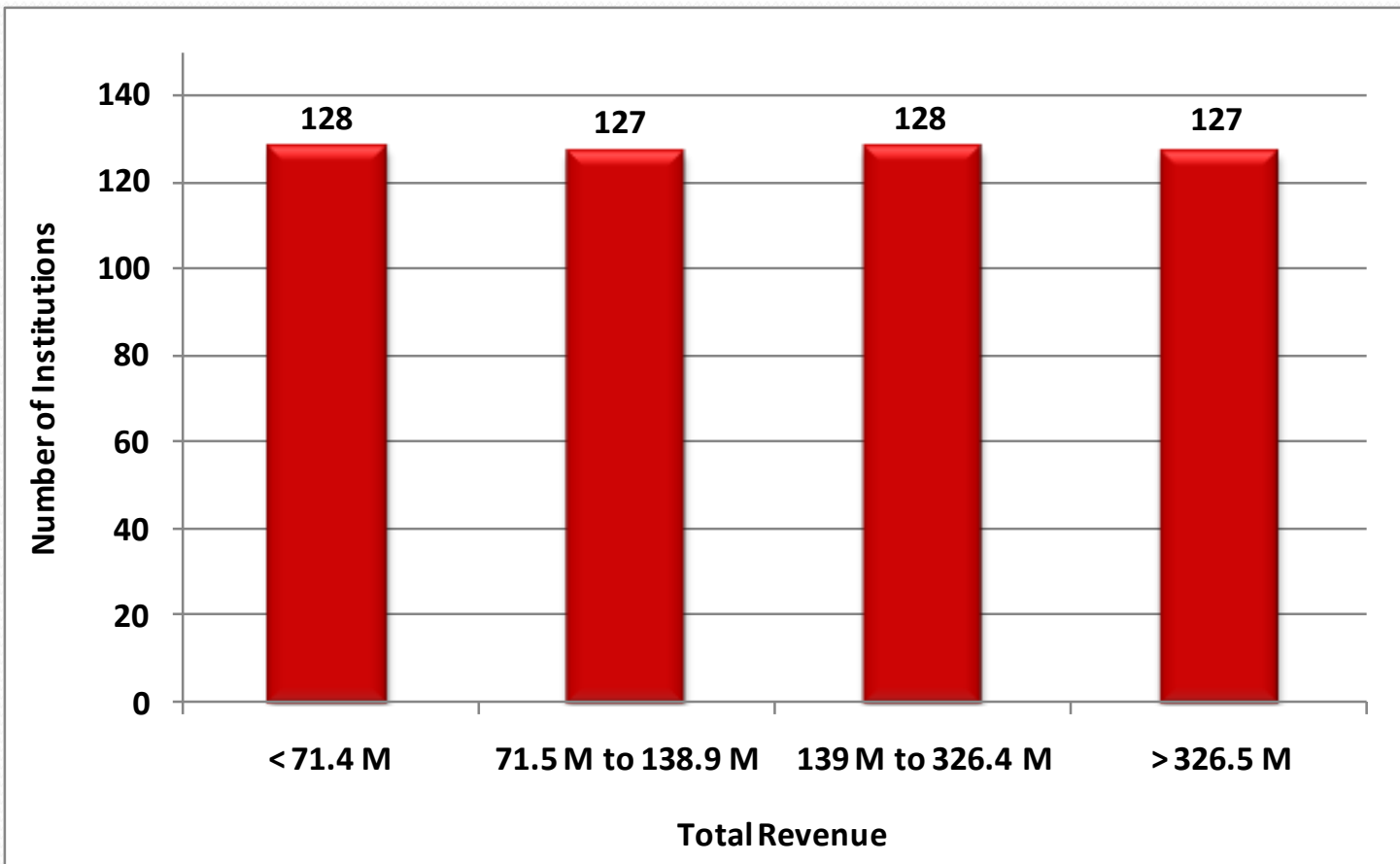

# RQ1 & 2 - About the Institutions...

- Of the 535 institutions studied, the total revenue generated in fiscal year 2006 ranged from \$5,183,435 to \$5,182,756,000.

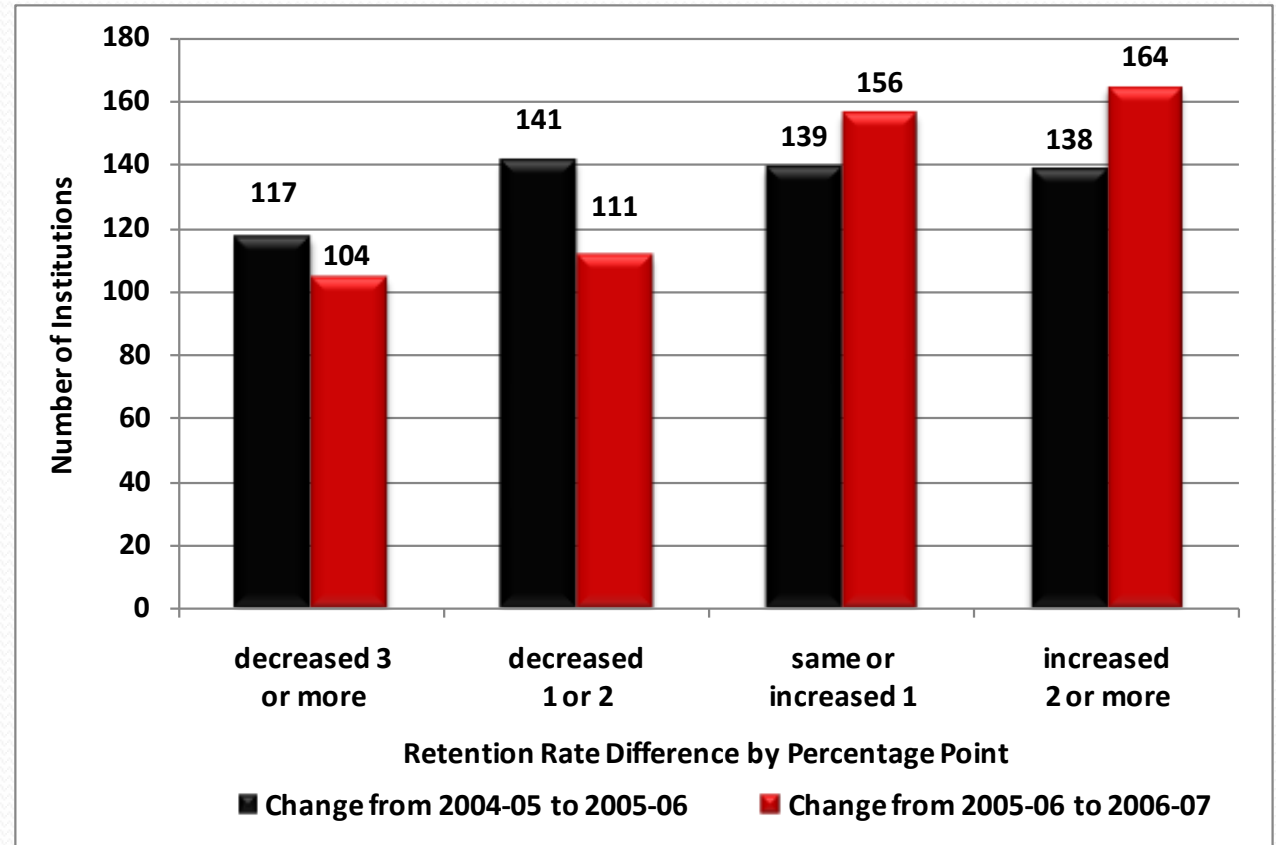

# RQ1—Results: Retention Rates

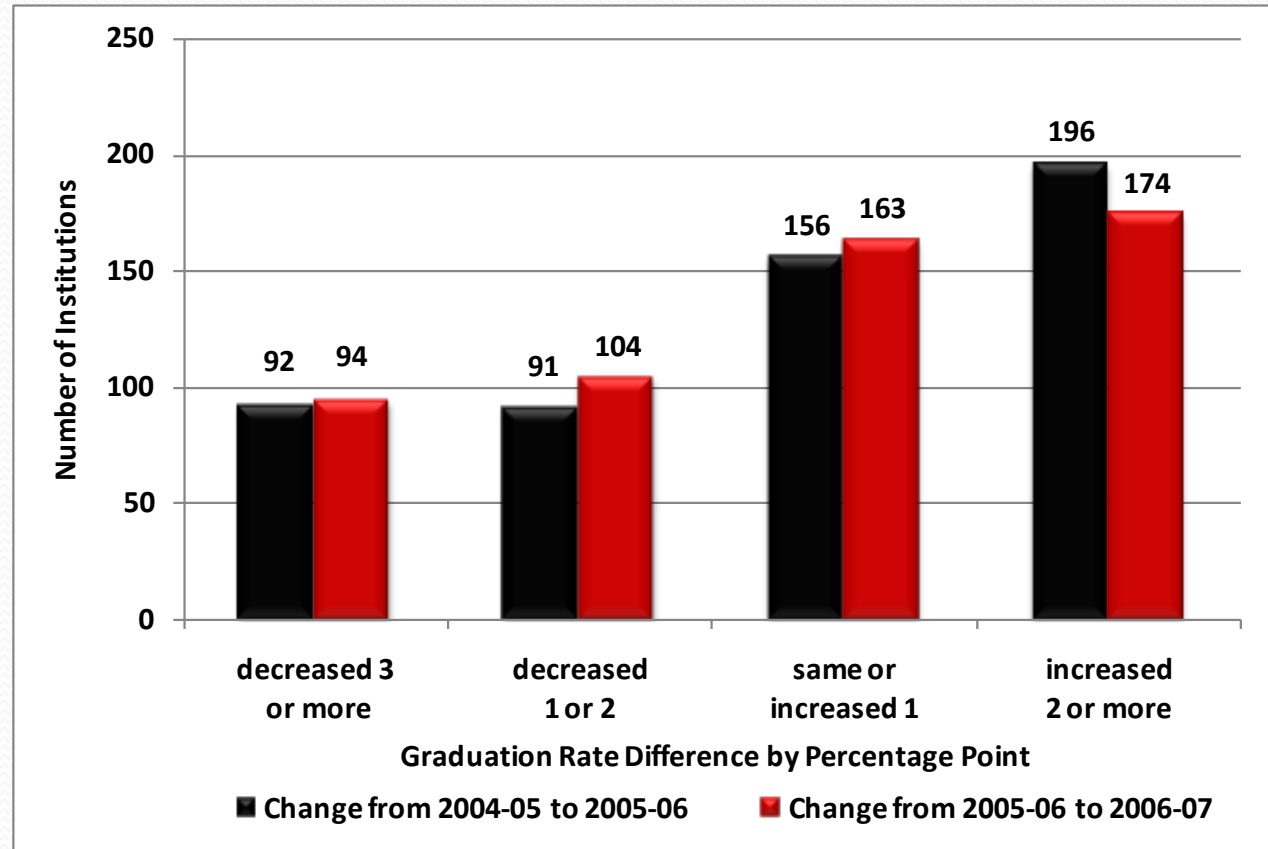
- 535 Institutions
  - From 2004 to 2005, institutions were evenly dispersed among differences
  - From 2005 to 2006, 59.81% of institutions had the no change or an increase in retention rates

# RQ2—Results: Graduation Rates

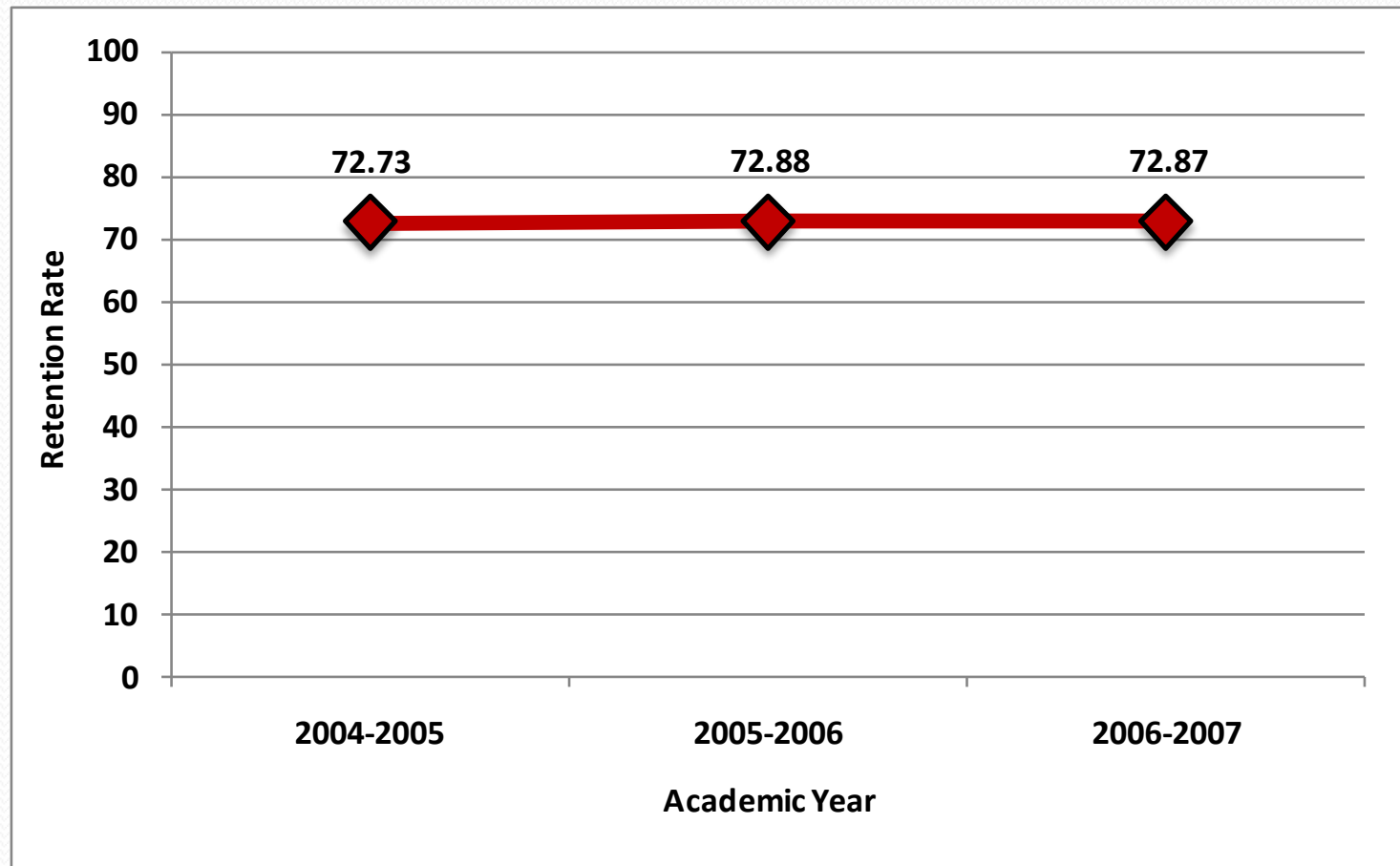
- 535 Institutions
  - From 2004 to 2005, 36.64% of institutions had increased 2 or more percentage points.
  - From 2005 to 2006, 30.47% of institutions either stayed the same or increased by one percentage point.

# RQ1—Results: Avg. Retention Rate

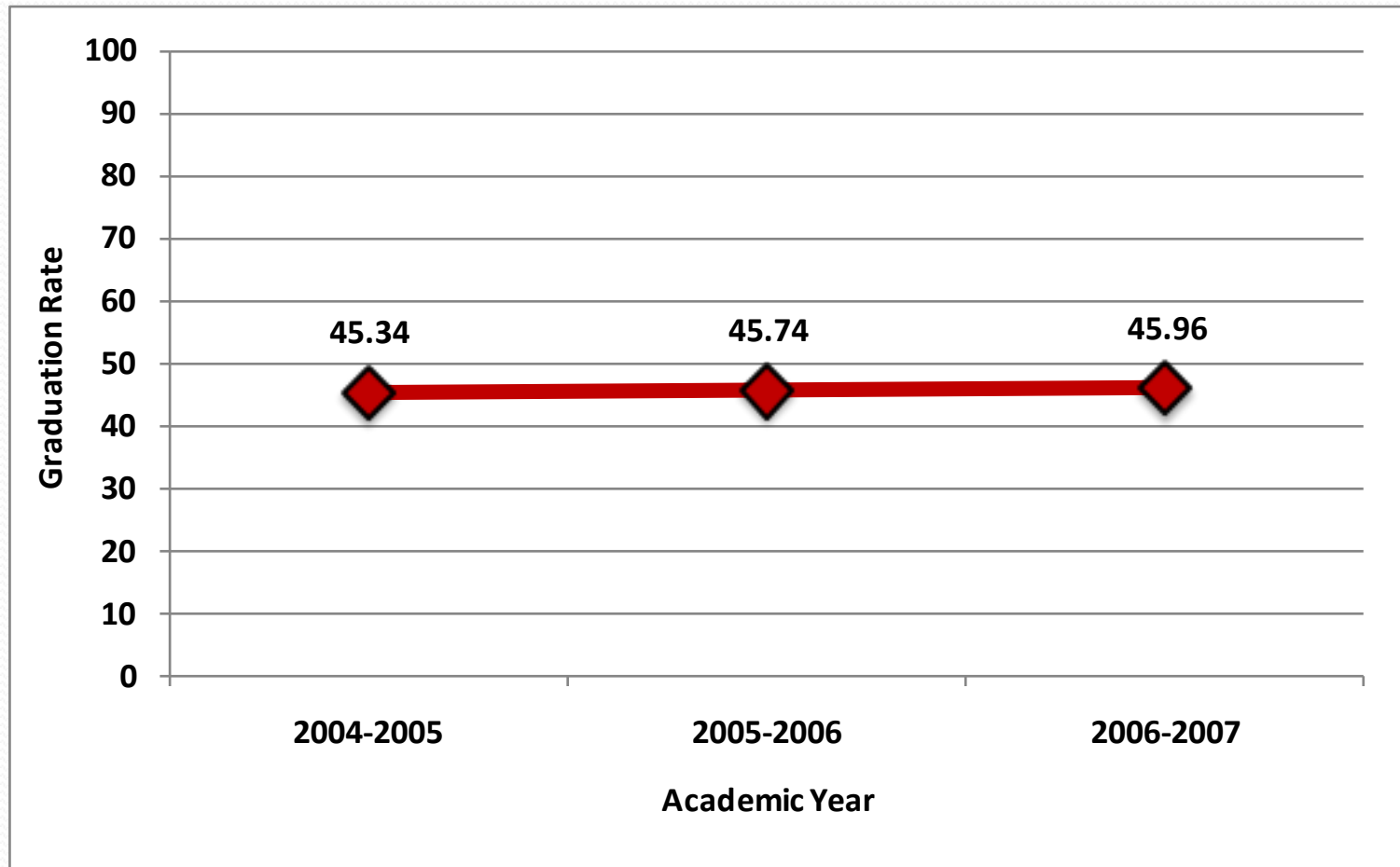
- The highest average retention rate (72.88%) occurred in 2005-06 academic year.

# RQ2—Results: Avg. Graduation Rates

- The highest average graduation rate (46.0%) occurred in 2006-07 academic year.

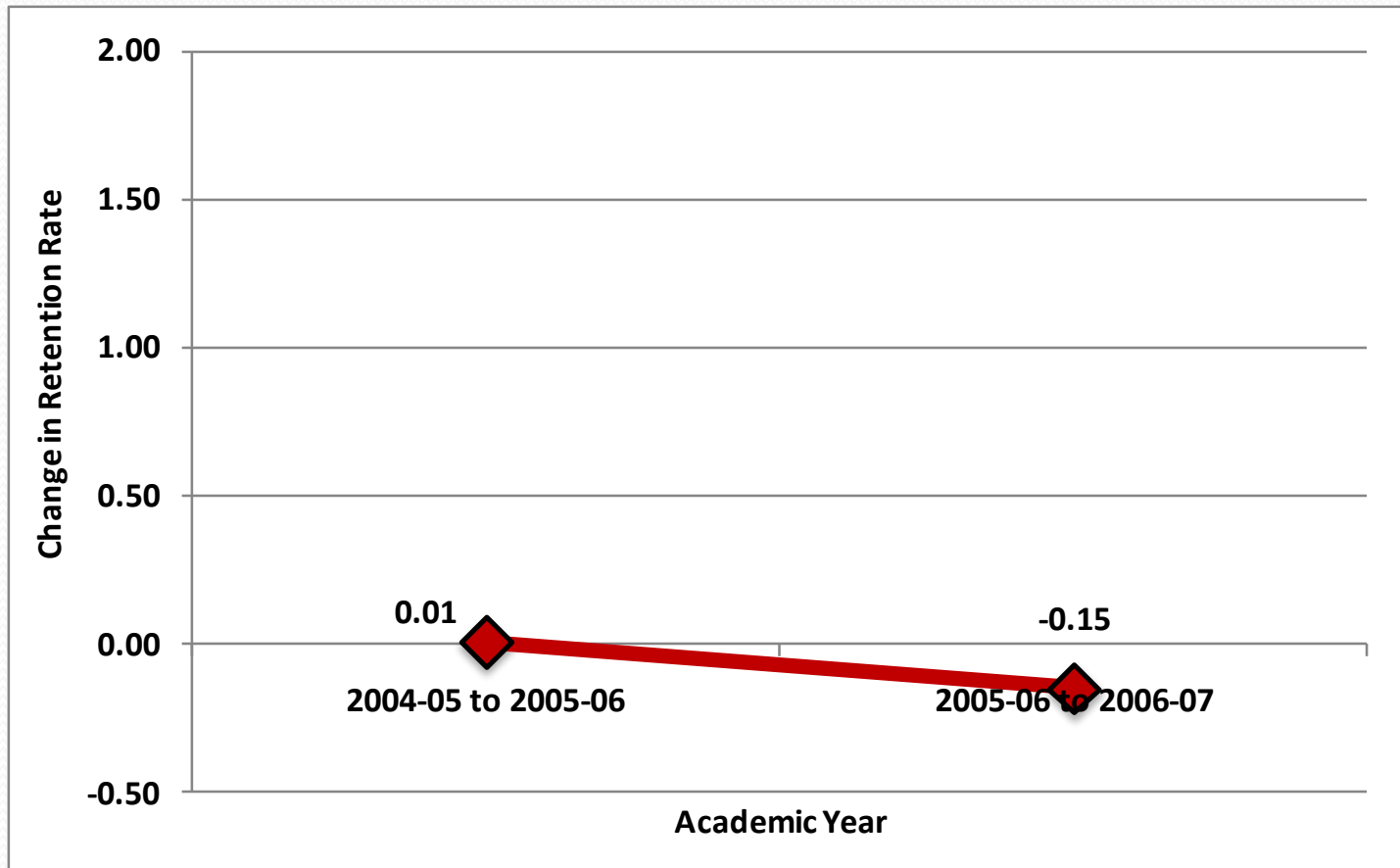

# RQ1—Results: Avg. Retention Rate Change

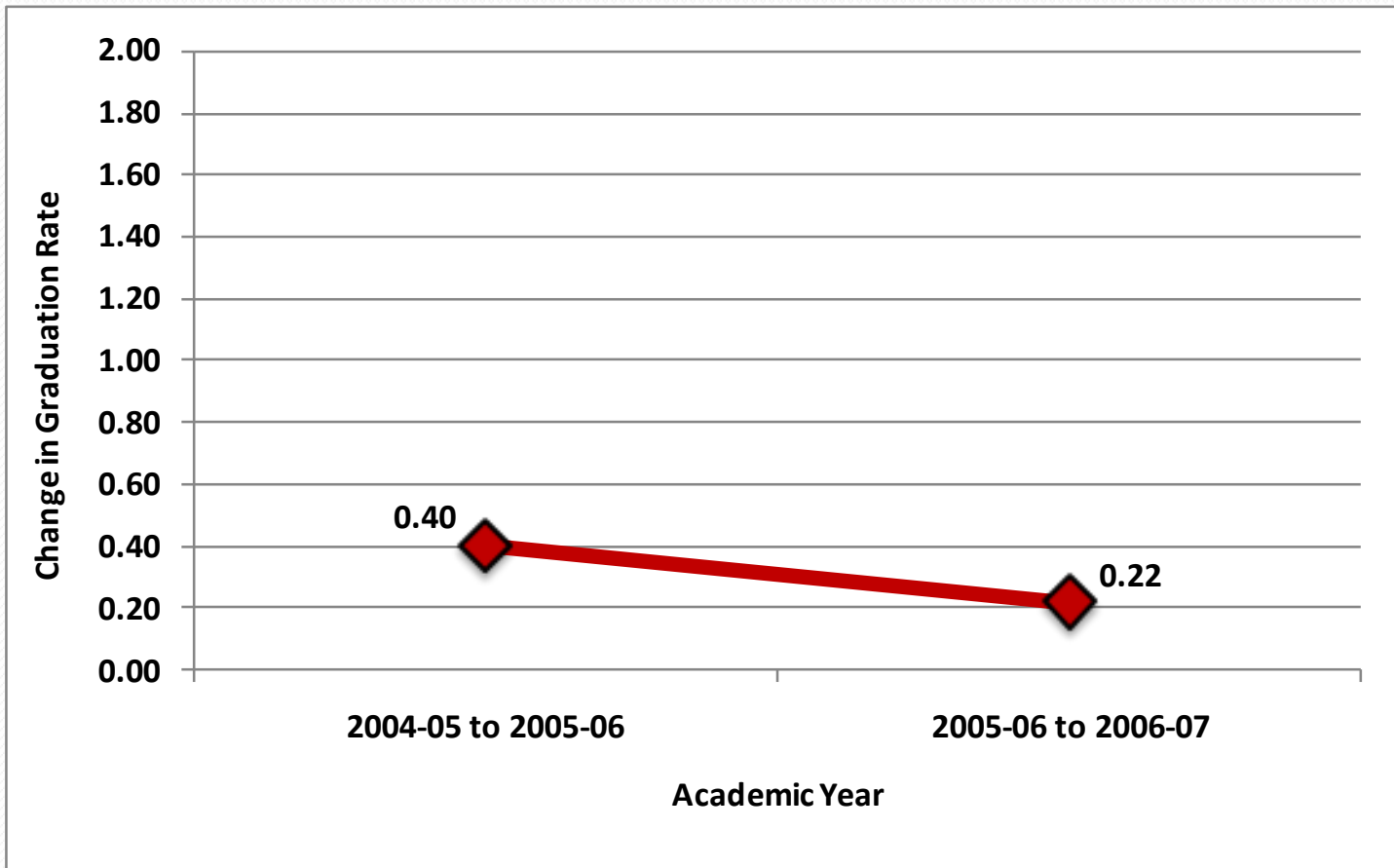
- **2005 to 2006** average retention rate gain was 0.01
- **2006 to 2007** average retention rate loss was 0.15

# RQ2—Results: Avg. Graduation Rate Change

- **2005 to 2006** average graduation rate gain was 0.40
- **2006 to 2007** average graduation rate gain was 0.22

# RQ1—Results

## Retention Rates

- 2004-05 to 2005-06
  - The highest percentage (12.18%) of institutions were generating greater than 311 million dollars and had no change in their retention rates or it increased by 1 percentage point.
- 2005-06 to 2006-07
  - The highest percentage (13.27%) of institutions were generating greater than 326.5 million dollars and had no change in their retention rates or it increased by 1 percentage point.

# RQ2—Results

## Graduation Rates

- 2004-05 to 2005-06
  - The highest percentage (11.03%) of institutions were generating greater than 311 million dollars and had no change in their retention rates or it increased by 1 percentage point.
- 2005-06 to 2006-07
  - The highest percentage (11.40%) of institutions were generating greater than 326.5 million dollars and had no change in their retention rates or it increased by 1 percentage point.

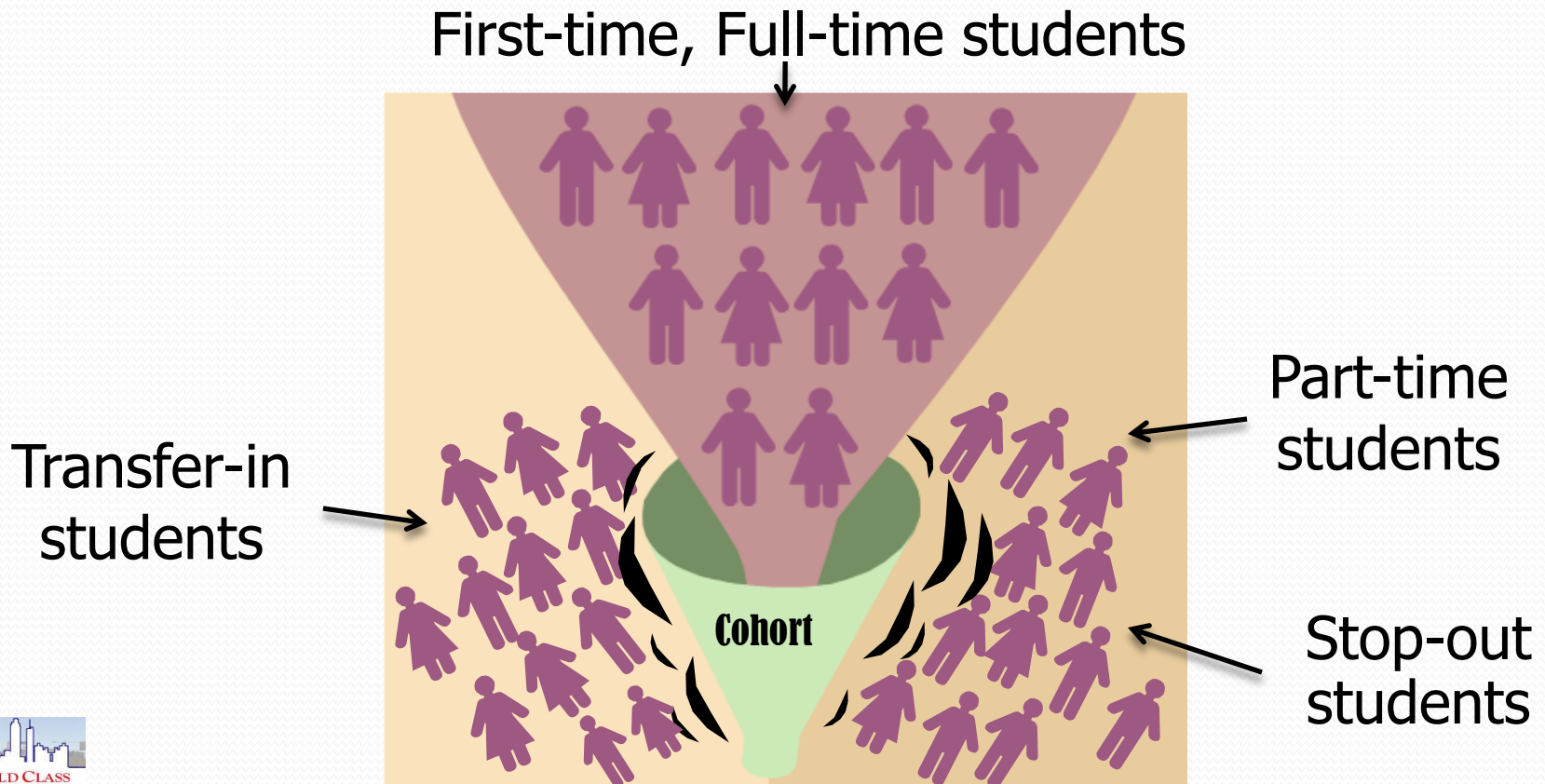
# RQ3 – Data, Variables, and Methods

- Current federal definitions do not provide accurate data on the number of students graduating
- Focus is on individual year cohorts – *NOT* on all cohorts on campus at any given time
  - Follows a point to point formula for success (i.e. only FTFT entering in 2002 **and** graduating in 2008 count)
  - Need to look at bigger view (i.e. all students who were part of any cohort who graduate in 2008)



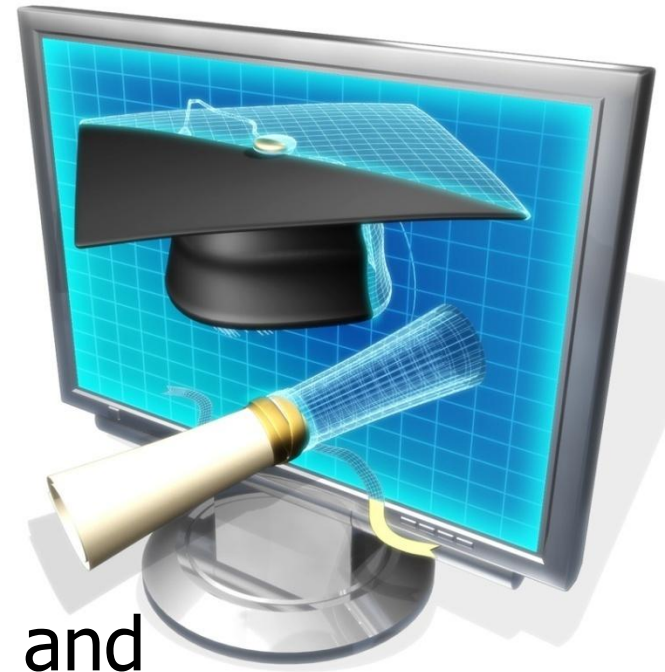
# RQ3 – Data, Variables, and Methods

Students entering outside the cohort are excluded.



# RQ3 – Data, Variables, and Methods

- 2005-2007 data for public four-year colleges or universities was extracted from IPEDS
- Variables used:
  - State
  - First-time, full-time cohort
  - Total undergraduates
  - Total students
  - Retention rate
  - Graduation rates (four, five, and six-year)

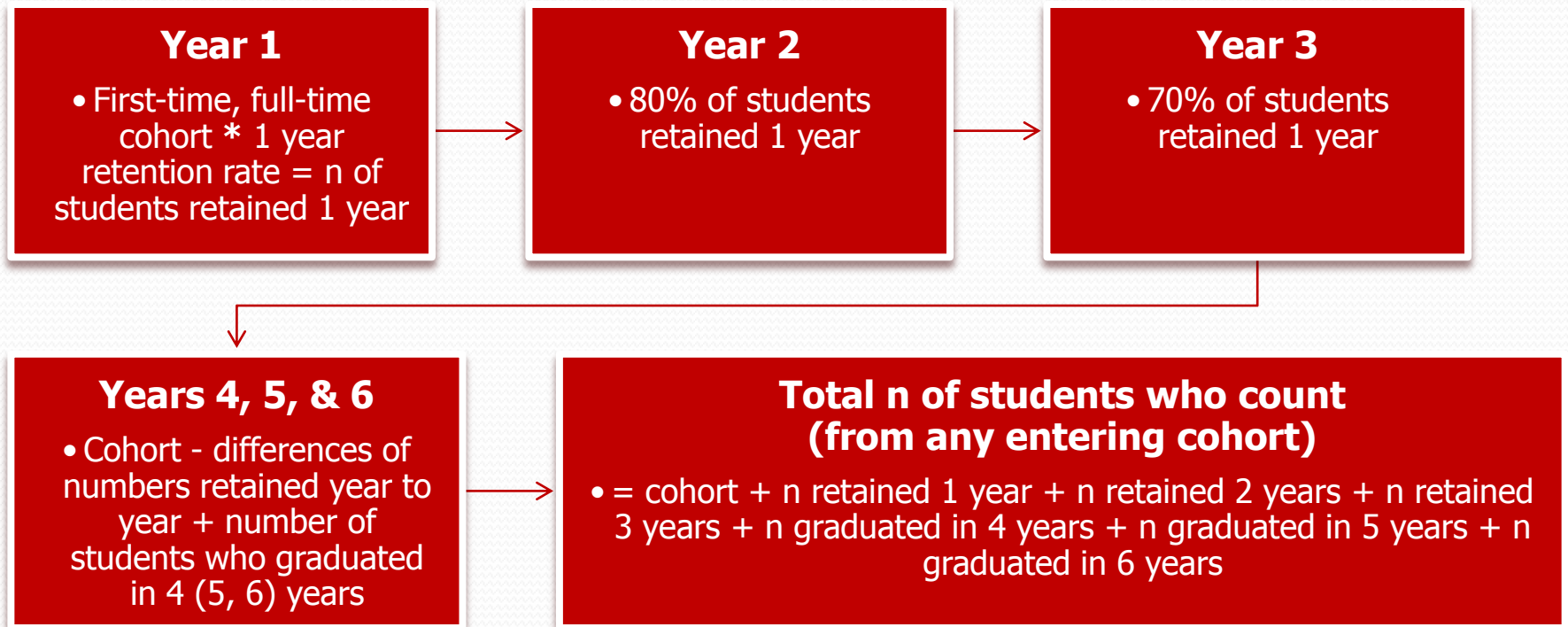

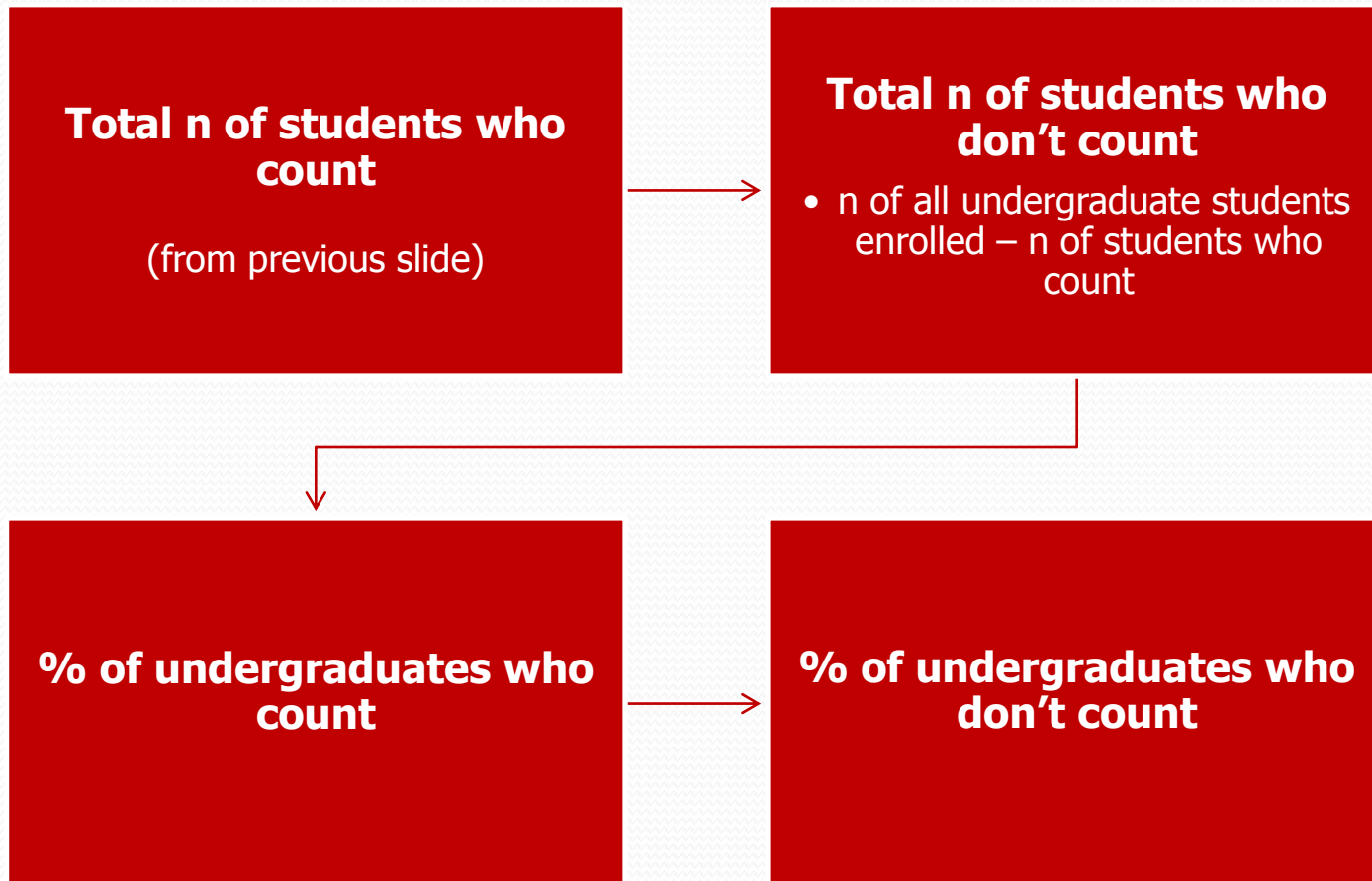

- Cohort formulas are horizontal and track a single cohort
- Snapshot formula is vertical and cumulative

# RQ3 – Limitations

- A formula based upon a single institution's data has been applied to multiple institutions.
- Data on private colleges or two-year colleges were not included.
- Institutions lacking three years worth of recent IPEDS trend data were eliminated from analysis.
- Institutions which generated figures outside the normal range (above 100% or below 0%) were removed from the final analysis.





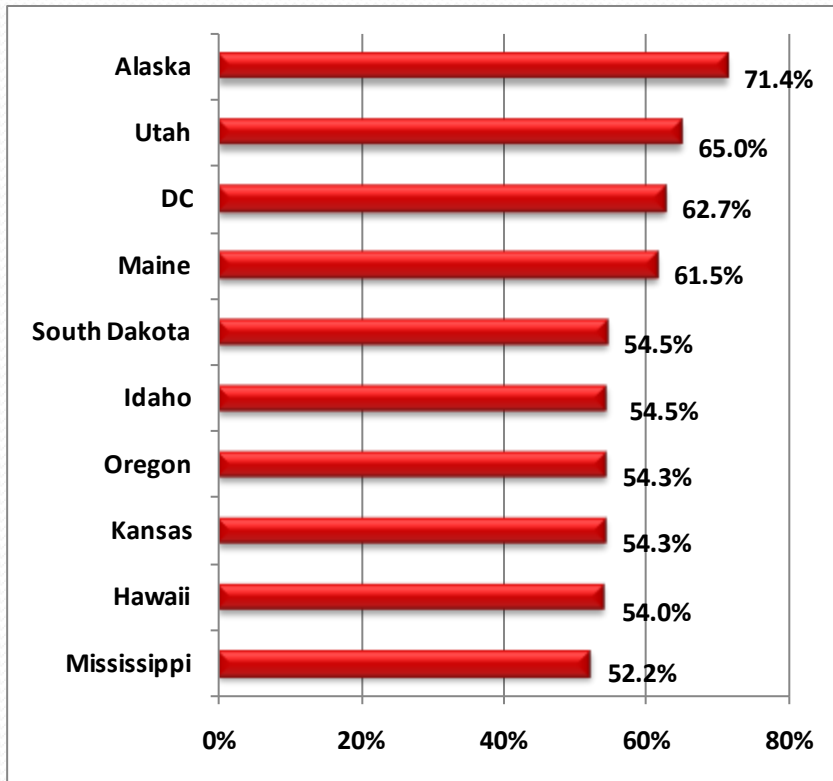
# RQ3 – Results

- 535 four-year public institutions remained for analysis
- Three-year averages of students who don't count were calculated
- Average percentage of students who don't count across all 535 institutions: 44.0%
- Additional three-year averages of students who don't count were calculated:
  - By institution
  - By state
  - By regional accrediting agency

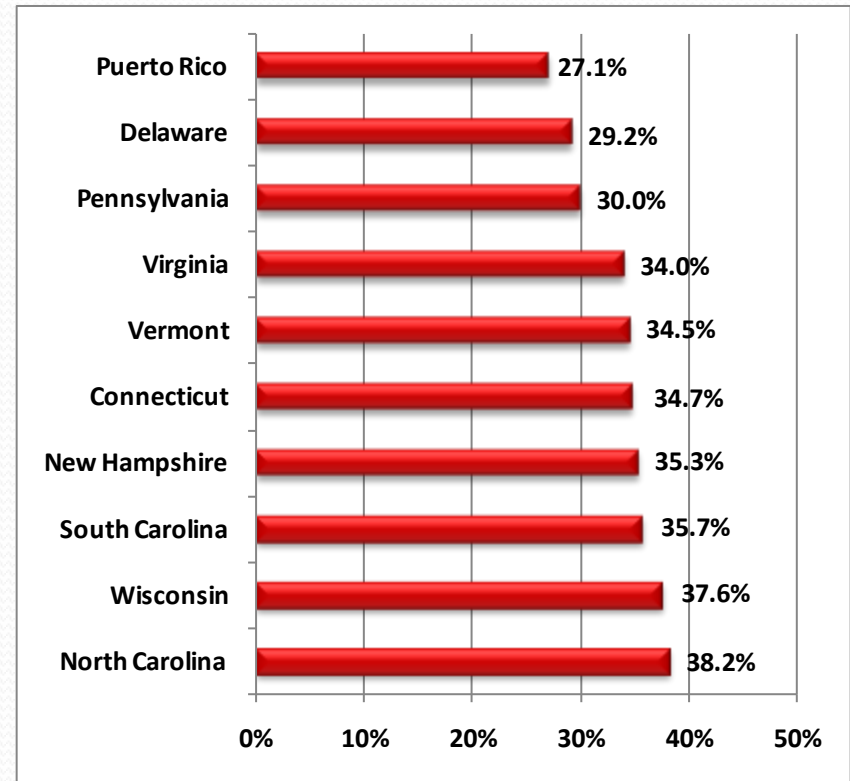


# RQ 3 Results: 3-Year Averages by State

## States with highest percentages of excluded students



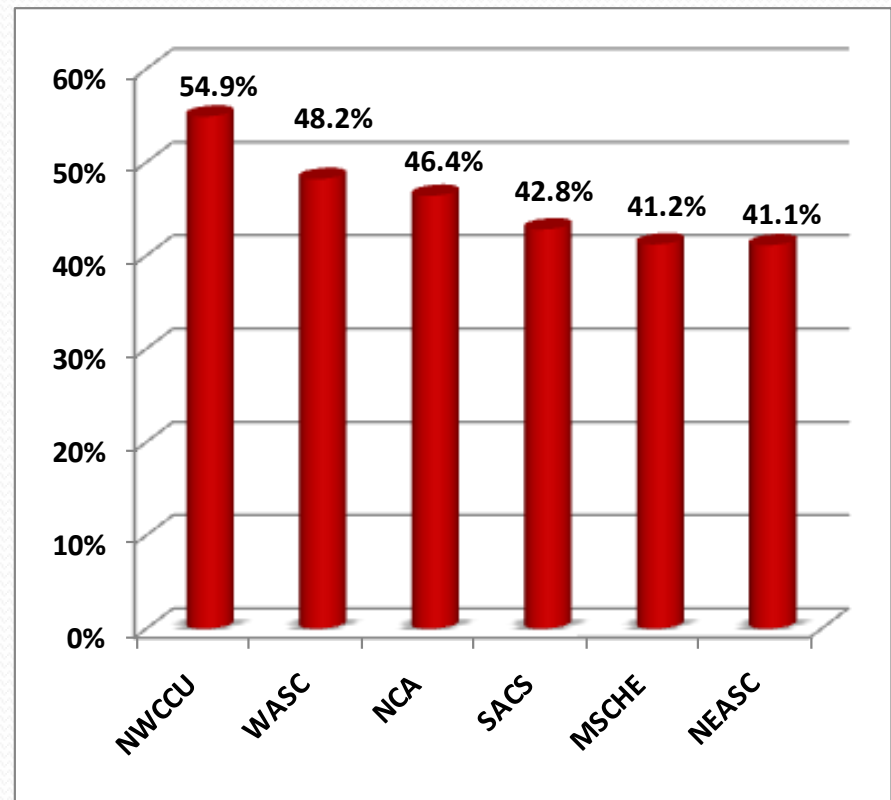
## States with lowest percentages of excluded students

# RQ3 Results: 3-Year Averages of Students Who Don't Count by Accrediting Body

- NWCCU has the highest average percentage of students who don't count of all accrediting bodies (54.9%)

# RQ3 – Results: Number of Students Who Do NOT Count

- The average number of students who don't count per year across all institutions was 43,023
- 12 states averaged a rate of over 60,000 students per year who don't count in current definitions

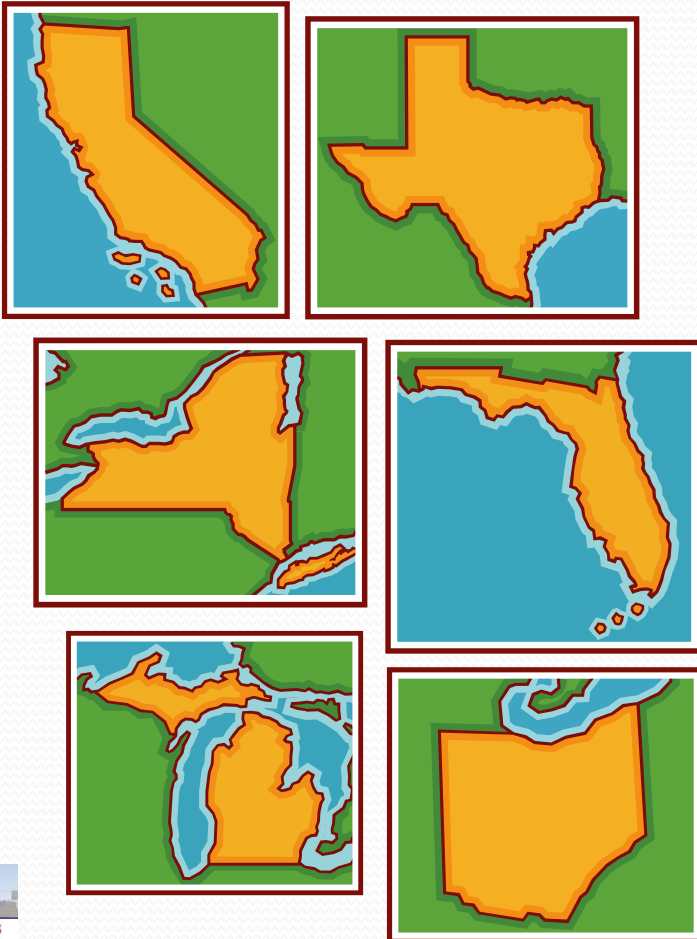

- Texas: 183,163
- New York: 122,103
- Florida: 111,360
- Michigan: 92,589
- Ohio: 82,289
- Pennsylvania: 71,122
- Georgia: 66,062

- Utah: 60,536
- North Carolina: 60,176

# RQ3 – Results: Number of Students Who Do NOT Count



- Average number of students who don't count per year from all 535 institutions: 2,323,226
- This is approximately the number of all students attending 4-year public institutions in California, Texas, New York, Florida, Michigan, and Ohio combined

# Discussion and Implications

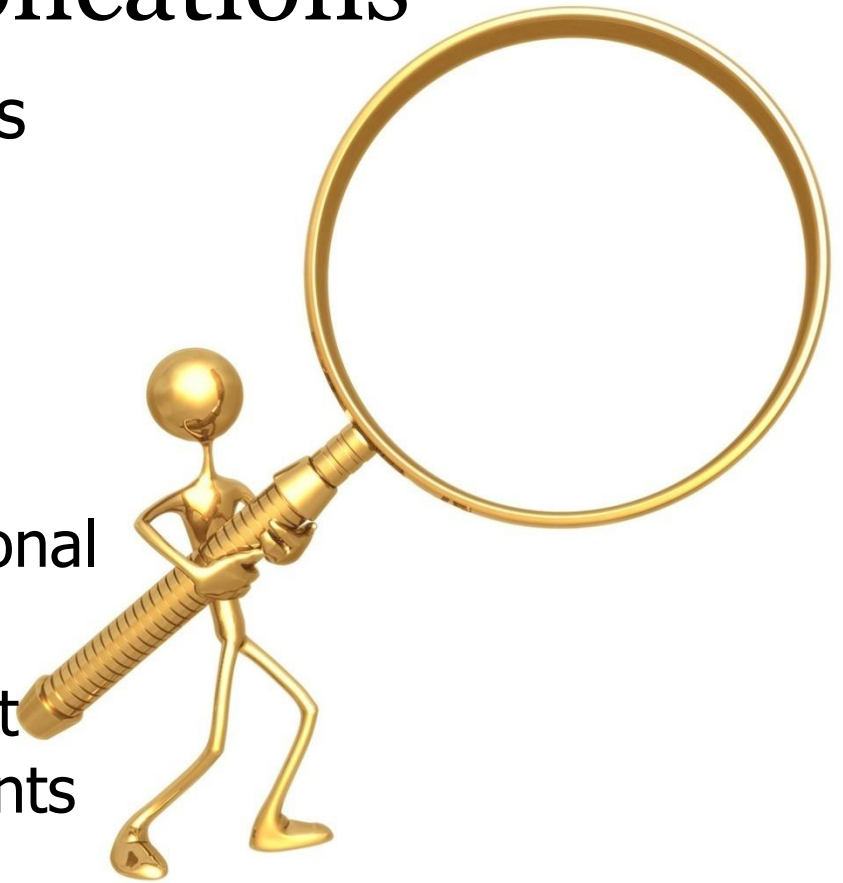
- Retention and graduation rates vary:
  - Year to year
  - State to state
  - Institution to institution
- Begs the question ... What should our institution's retention and graduation rate increase goal be?
  - See handout
  - Discussion of examples





# Discussion and Implications

- More than 2 million students are excluded from being counted
  - Inaccurate view of student success
  - Inaccurate view of institutional effectiveness
  - Suggests to institutions that they should focus on students that “count”





# Discussion and Implications

- Critical issues for institutions/administrators that receive funding based upon retention and/or graduation rates
- Revise or add new definitions to count all students
  - HEA Reauthorization in 2014

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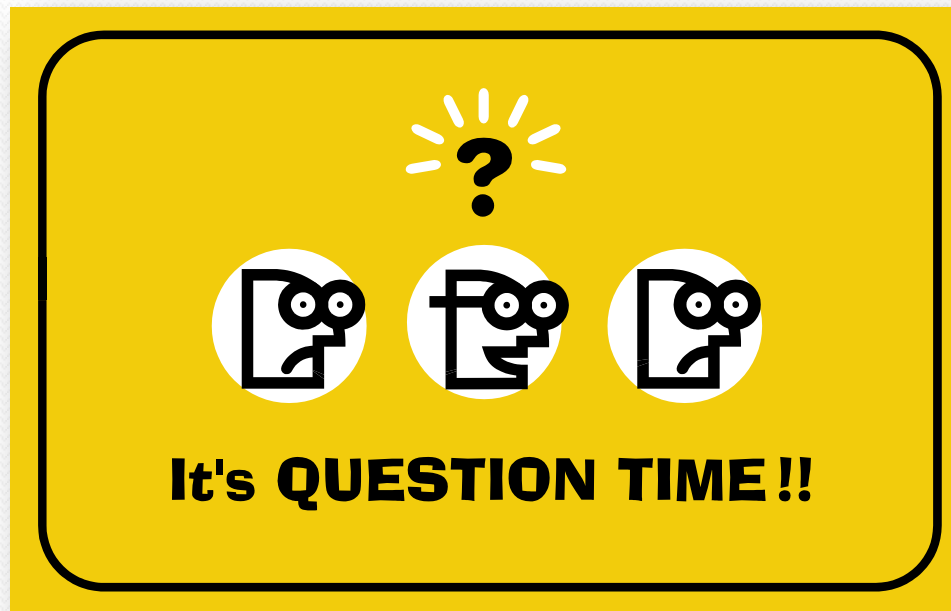
